

WE HAVE 3 WASTE COLLECTION STREAMS – 1. RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS 2. RECYCLABLE PAPER 3. REGULAR GARBAGE.

NOT COLLECTED - Compost, Household Hazardous Waste, AND Leaf and Yard wastes. METAL ITEMS larger than 1ft², are collected ONCE PER YEAR (in late Spring 2012) or may be taken to the landfill year round. Electronics (e.g. televisions, computers, monitors, audio/video systems, phones) must be taken to the recycling depot at 79 Centennial Dr. Windsor. For more info, call 798-6943.



BAG # 1 RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS



BLUE OR CLEAR BAG
ALL ITEMS MUST BE RINSED
10 BAG LIMIT - counting
Bag #1 & Bag #2

- Beverage Containers – glass, aluminum or plastic or can be returned to any ENVIRO-DEPOT™ for a refund.
- Milk Cartons – includes juice, molasses, soy and rice milk.
- Steel/Tin food cans (soup, pet food etc.), clean aluminum foil and pie plates (soiled ones are regular garbage)
- Glass food jars and bottles.
- Plastic Containers: margarine, ice cream, detergent, fabric softener, windshield washer containers, pails and lids, all plastic bottles - ketchup, soap, cleaner, beauty, shampoo etc.
- Plastic Bags: grocery bags, milk bags, bread bags etc.

BAG # 2 RECYCLABLE PAPER



BLUE OR CLEAR BAG
KEEP PAPER SEPARATED
10 BAG LIMIT – counting
Bag #1 & Bag #2

- Newsprint and flyers- including glossy (may go in a separate grocery bag)
- Paper - bond, shredded paper, writing paper, envelopes etc.
- Paper egg cartons (take-out trays etc.)
- Books - Phone books, paper back and soft cover books, catalogues, magazines etc.
- Box board – cereal, tissue boxes, **toilet paper rolls** etc.
- Paper bags (flour, sugar, and pet food bags without plastic liners)
- WRAPPING PAPER IS REGULAR GARBAGE


CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Fold ALL boxes flat (do not put pieces inside a box). Tie or tape in bundles 2ft x 3ft x 8 inches and place bundle beside bags.

KEEP CLEAN AND DRY

ALWAYS KEEP SEPARATED
FROM BAG #1 ITEMS

GARBAGE



CLEAR BAG (26"x36" size)
One SMALL privacy bag allowed
BAG LIMIT IS 6
OR 1 Bulky item and 5 bags

- Styrofoam: meat trays, cups, packing, and insulation
 - Non-compostable food items (e.g. fats, meat, fish, bones, dairy products)
 - Broken glass/light bulbs boxed and labeled.
 - Disposable batteries
 - Plant pots/trays
 - Ashes (completely cooled)
 - DRY empty paint cans
 - Empty motor oil containers
 - Household furniture (sofas, chairs, mattresses etc.)
 - Small appliances (coffee maker, microwave etc.)
 - OTHER: - clothing, diapers, sanitary napkins, toothpaste tubes, latex gloves, scouring pads, candy wrappers, chip bags, carpet, wallpaper, plastic items (lawn chairs, sheeting, thick bags) metal pieces smaller than 1ft², bottle caps and lids etc.
- Loose bulky items to be bundled.

COMPOSTABLE ORGANICS Backyard Composter



Residents are required to backyard compost their organic waste. Put in composter: Fruit and vegetable peels/cores, rice/pasta/grains, coffee grounds/filters and tea bags, paper towels and napkins, egg shells, soiled paper, baked goods, breads, leaves/grass clippings. Put in garbage: meat, fish and shell fish, bones, fat/grease/oil, dairy/cheese, pet waste, weeds gone to seed and diseased plants. See website for hints and tips.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (H.H.W.) (Residential Drop off depot at landfill site)



NOT COLLECTED - anything labeled danger, poisonous, caution, toxic, corrosive, flammable or explosive. DO NOT put in recycle or garbage. TAKE IT to the depot (landfill) ONLY RESIDENTIAL H.H.W. ACCEPTED. EXCEPTION: Empty aerosol spray cans or paint cans are regular garbage. Drop PAINT ONLY at any ENVIRO-DEPOT™ for recycling.

LARGE METAL COLLECTION

Once per year collection in
Late Spring 2012
Metal items larger than 1ft² and 70%
metal collected (some exceptions).
