The Nova Scotia *Municipal Government Act* specifies that all municipalities must review their governance arrangements in 2006 and every eight years thereafter. To comply with this requirement for 2022, West Hants Regional Municipality is reviewing the district boundaries adopted at the time of its creation on April 1, 2020.

The current arrangement of 11 districts was adopted following a study by Stantec Consulting Limited and consultation with the public undertaken as part of the process that consolidated the Town of Windsor with the Municipality of the District of West Hants in 2018. Because the current Council size and electoral boundaries were defined recently, the Municipality has chosen to focus on boundary adjustments necessary to ensure balance in the number of electors (i.e., eligible voters) in each district and has engaged Stantec to carry out the required study.

The following questionnaire presents the current electoral boundary arrangement and an alternative created by Stantec to improve the balance in the number of electors. Although the adjustments to numbers are moderate, the alterations to some electoral district boundaries are significant. Please look at the two enclosed maps carefully to see how changes may affect your district and the overall pattern of municipal representation in West Hants.

Electoral District Boundaries

The maps included with this survey represent the boundaries of the current 11 electoral districts for West Hants Regional Municipality and an adjusted arrangement in which the boundaries have been revised to better meet Province of Nova Scotia criteria for assessing electoral districts. The key criteria for setting these boundaries are to create districts in which the number of electors is within or as close as possible to $\pm 10\%$ of the average number of electors for all districts and to respect the integrity of existing communities. In the current 11-district arrangement, Districts 1, 2, 6, and 7 are outside the $\pm 10\%$ criterion, Districts 1 and 6 with substantial variations. In the adjusted arrangement, which follows, District 7 is slightly above 10%.



West Hants Regional Municipality Electoral District Boundary






