

Green Cart



- All food waste including meat, fish, bones & shells
 - Cooking oil and fat
 - Yard Waste, leaves, brush, weeds, sawdust and small branches
 - Paper towels, napkins, tissues, wrapping paper, sugar & flour bags, pizza and detergent boxes
 - Coffee filters and tea bags
- Boxboard or a sheet of paper may be used to wrap wet food waste in to control mess.

- NO plastic bags (including those labelled as "compostable")
- NO ashes
- NO coffee cups, milk cartons, glass, metal or garbage.
- YES extra leaves in paper (up to 3) bags or 2 bags and 1 bundle of branches

Recycle Bag 1



- All plastic containers (ice cream, yogurt, cake & cookie trays, shampoo bottles, cleaning fluid bottles, windshield washer containers, etc.)
- Beer & pop cans and liquor bottles—these may also be taken to the Enviro-Depot for a refund
- All plastic bags
- Milk and juice containers (caps removed)
- Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- Aluminum foil and plates
- Tin/aluminum/steel food cans

ALL MUST BE CLEAN & DRY

- NO styrofoam™
- NO paper
- NO plastic cutlery
- NO disposable cups
- NO broken glass

Recycle Bag 2



- Boxboard (cereal & cracker boxes and pizza boxes)
- Paper including shredded
- Paper egg cartons
- Newsprint and flyers
- Catalogues, books (remove hard covers), magazines and phone books
- Envelopes

Flatten and bundle corrugated cardboard boxes to 3'x2'x8".



All boxes must be flat.
Bundles can be secured with string or packing tape.

Garbage



- Empty aerosol (non-paint or automotive lubricants)
- Pet waste
- Broken glass (wrapped and labeled)
- Coffee cups
- Potato chip bags
- Styrofoam
- Clothing & textiles
- Diapers and sanitary products
- Ashes (cold)
- Small appliances like vacuum, coffee maker, lamp etc.
- Furniture
- Rolled carpet
- Floor sweepings
- Dirty aluminum foil

Household Hazardous Waste

Other

- Paint and paint cans—take to any Enviro-Depot. Visit regeneration.ca for drop off sites
- Electronics—take to Recycling Center at New Boundaries, 79 Centennial Drive, Windsor
- Batteries—take to Municipal Office, 76 Morison Drive or HHW Depot at the landfill
- Clothes & Textiles—consider donating old clothes & shoes
- Medications/ Syringes—contact your local pharmacy for safe sharps containers and drug return program
