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Hi everyone,

I know this is a busy and devastating time for many people in West Hants. I just finished cleaning my home of sewage sludge for a third time in three years.

I know you are all aware of this and we are so very grateful for all of you that came to our aid last night and continue to fight for us.

I apologize for sending a late email but I can't get this off my mind. A neighbour shared a picture of me last night and it has completely shattered me.

This is a picture of me (and friends) carrying my children (5, 8 and 9) out of my home. As parents, we do what we have to without a second thought. My children needed to get out of our flooding home but there was no way I could let them walk through the sewage water.

This is really hitting me hard tonight. My husband and I have sheltered our children from these floods up until now. They weren't home for the last two but they saw the devastation this time. My 5 year old told me his belly hurt because he was worried the grown ups would get sick from being in the sewage water. When my neighbour fell and went completely under the sewage water, she had a panic attack on our front steps. My 5 year old, without anyone asking, went and got her a glass of water.

We are so tried. Literally and figuratively. I am a hard worker and an honest person and year after year more and more is taken from me and I am worried our health is being taken from us as well. A firefighter last night urged us to get hepatitis shots as it is a requirement for them to work in similar waters.

We need out. I know you all know this and I thank you for voting yes on reports on buyouts.

My husband and I have worked so hard for what we have. We can't continue to lose. Please

fight for us to have fair buyouts so we can relocate and not lose more. I LOVE Windsor. I want to raise my children in Windsor. Please help us.
