---Good morning,

Several residents living in the Windsor flood zone are concerned that the sewer odour is becoming noticeable again in the area.

Residents are anticipating the need to avoid, when possible, walking near catch basins and many residents are concerned they will, again, not be able to open windows or use yards and decks in the summer months because of the often strong, offensive sewer odour.

In addition to the odour being offensive, prolonged exposure, even in low concentrations, poses a health and safety risk, (irritated eyes, nose, throat and respiratory system, headaches, dizziness, nausea, vomiting etc). Residents living in close proximity to catch basins (near or at driveways etc) cannot avoid this exposure.

A motion directing staff to look into possible solutions was made in October 2023 and has remained on the Dashboard with the note, 'approved, report to follow'. As spring and summer 2024 approaches, could this motion be revised and explored for possible remedial action?
