Subject: Curb side garbage pickup

Good afternoon,

My name is Edward Curtis and my wife and I live at [REDACTED] Forest Lakes. I am sending this email to ask if council would look at providing curb side pickup for our subdivision. The garbage and compost situation here is pretty bad due to animal activity and illegal dumping.

We are paying almost \$4500 in property taxes, \$1500 for snow plowing and \$200 for road grading. We have no municipal support but still pay a tax rate at the same levels as areas with full service.

There is a house in our neighbourhood that is on the market for \$1499900 and is accessed at \$1,100,000. If this house sells the new owners will have to pay over \$10,000 a year in property taxes. They will have no municipal services other than Fire and RCMP. This lack of service is a hindrance to the selling of property within our neighborhood affecting the amount of taxes that are paid to the municipality.
