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Mayor Zebian and Councillor Leary-Pinch, I want to follow up on a recent CBC story about uranium and provide some information that may be of help to you and your colleagues on council.

There are many misconceptions about uranium so we have a report at <https://tmans.ca/uranium> which explains why uranium is considered essential to achieving climate goals (it is the key fuel for emissions-free nuclear power) and why global experts say there is no health, safety or environmental reason not to mine it (i.e. the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission, the science-based Government of Canada regulator of uranium mines, says “Mining activities are safe for the health of people and the environment...”).
