I am contacting you in regards to the recent overturn of the moratorium and ban on uranium exploration and mining in Nova Scotia. Although the proposed sites are in specific regions of NS, including West Hants, the informed know that the potential for harm and contamination will affect our whole province.

This ban was put in place specifically to keep our province and people safe from a potentially disastrous industrial activity. This spring, when Bill 6 moved to overturn the ban, I was horrified.

It is likely that you are already receiving many long emails with statistics and links about the disastrous consequences of uranium mining. At your request, I can also present you with resources. We were also grateful to hear the information you gathered from your meetings with the province at council last night.

Myself and my spouse are categorically and completely against uranium exploration and mining in Nova Scotia.

Furthermore, we request a pause in the granting of exploration licences so that the people of Nova Scotia can have more time to fully understand the risks with accurate information.
