West Hants Regional Municipal Advisory Board Committee Report

Region 6 Inter-Municipal meeting November 28, 2025

- Annual election of Chair and Vice Chair deferred until March 2026 meeting as committee member appointments was outstanding for some units.
- Region 6 Budget 2026-27 approved to go to Councils. Municipal portion to be shared by the Region 6 units is \$147,885. The portion due by West Hants is \$31,258.41 and the budget will be presented to West Hants CO TW Jan 13th.
- Extended Producer Responsibility for Packaging, Printed Paper Packaging-Like Products (EPR for PPP) Program started Dec 1st. Most (45 of 49) municipalities Opted-In and will continue to manage their recyclables program and be compensated by Circular Materials (CM). Four municipalities (Towns of Antigonish and Yarmouth, Municipality of Yarmouth and the Region of Queens) Opted-Out and Circular Materials will be responsible for the cost of managing the recycling program.
- The Region of Queens decided to close their Recycling Facility Dec 1st as a suitable agreement could not be reached with CM to continue operations.
- The Shelburne Shared Service expects to close their Construction & Demolition (C&D) Transfer Station Facility by late December as the cost of required site upgrades to meet regulatory requirements, seem to be too great to be borne by the area residents. Alternatives are being investigated.
