

Good evening, Mayor, Deputy Mayor, and Council.

My name is Harley Gray. I am the President of the Windsor Plains Cultural Association, which was established in 2016. Our non-profit organization currently has 5 directors including myself, Tristan Sampson, Wade Hamilton, Anthony Gray, and Juanita Gray.

Our organization took over ownership of Panuke Road Park in approximately 2017 from another community organization that was in default with the Registry of Joint Stocks. Since then, we have owned and maintained the park. We have received grants and completed projects to improve the park.

Our goal is to maintain this park for the community's enjoyment. However, it has been difficult to maintain aspects of the park due to lack of volunteers, time constraints and skill level of volunteers.

I am here tonight, as the representative of the Windsor Plains Cultural Association, to make two requests for Council to consider:

1. A one-time request for Municipal staff to install two basketball nets, which had been donated by Acadia University.

And;

2. For the Municipality to enter into a 4-month Maintenance Agreement with the Organization, for grass cutting around the Basketball court, baseball field and surrounding area. I will continue to cut the grass around the playground area.
