



Bailey Drive Rehabilitation

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Municipality of the District of West Hants has awarded a contract to Dexter Construction to overhaul Bailey Drive in the community of Garlands Crossing. The scope of work includes the following plan:

1. Set up and perform all traffic control and site utilities;
2. Excavate and rebuild road base at the end of Bailey Drive to accommodate a traffic turning circle (cul-de-sac) within municipal property boundaries;
3. Supply and place hot asphalt to build base for new turning circle;
4. Mill existing asphalt around structures as required for thin lift overlay;
5. Supply and place tack coat prior to paving;
6. Supply and place hot asphalt over the existing asphalt street and new turning circle;
7. On completion, demobilize all equipment and perform entire site clean-up; and
8. Reinstatement of road shoulder.

Schedule:

Construction is scheduled to be completed before the end of June. Hours of work will generally be weekdays from 7 am to 7 pm. While construction is ongoing, the work area will be limited to local traffic only during work hours, causing some minor delays. It is not anticipated that dedicated traffic control personnel will be utilized for the project.

Communication/Contacts:

The Municipality encourages open communication during construction projects, particularly in areas adjacent to your property. On site personnel will make every effort to keep residents informed and advised of scheduled interruptions for driveway access, whenever possible. We appreciate your understanding and patience.
