Acquisition of the former DAR Line**

Q&A

Q1: How did the Municipality acquire the lands?

A1: The land acquisition was completed on January 31, 2023, and we now hold clear title to all lands within West Hants Regional Municipality.

Q2: What is the current status of the land?

A2: The lands formerly know as the Dominion Atlantic Railway (DAR) between Stanley and Mantua are now owned by the West Hants Regional Municipality.

Q3: What if I have a licence, lease, or easement agreement with the previous landowner?

A3: All existing agreements that are registered with the Land Registry Office transferred with the ownership. If you believe you have a registered agreement, please contact the Municipality to confirm.

Q3: Is this an active multi-use trail system?

A3: This is not considered an active multi-use trail system at this time.

Q4: What are the future plans/next steps for the former DAR line?

A4: The Municipality has started to address immediate safety concerns and is interested in working with stakeholders create a multi use trail.
